DR. GERALD EDELIST AWARD

This award is given to a Department faculty member who is judged to be an outstanding teacher of residents in our program. It may be given annually if the selection committee identifies a worthy recipient. An individual may receive this award only once in any ten year period.

Nomination criteria may include:

- a) An excellent teaching record over at least three years
- b) Excellence in clinical teaching, lectures, and seminars
- c) Demonstrated interest and activity to improve teaching
- d) Development of innovations to improve learning
- e) Involvement in educational research
- f) Active involvement in educational committees and/or administration

Members of the Department of Anesthesia are invited to nominate candidates. Residents wishing assistance in a nomination should contact their hospital coordinator.

Nominations packages must include

- A nomination letter signed by at least four (4) faculty members and three (3) residents
- One or two (not more) additional letters of support signed by peers and residents
- Teaching evaluation data from the last three years
- If nominated for research or educational innovation, evidence of achievement
- The candidate's Curriculum Vitae

NOTE: The Education Council is the selection panel for awards and members may not contribute to nominations and are not eligible for nomination. They are the Department Chair; the Vice-Chair, Education; Directors of the undergraduate program, fellowships, continuing education, and faculty development; and Directors of the residency programs in anesthesia, family practice anesthesia, and pain medicine.
