FORMAL ACADEMIC CURRICULUM – PAIN MEDICINE RESIDENCY

The Pain Medicine Residency offers a rich formalized academic curriculum based on the International Association for the Study of Pain (IASP) 3rd ed. Core Curriculum for Professional Education and also incorporates some of the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) requirements for training in Pain Medicine.

1. Pain Medicine Residents must attend the multidisciplinary didactic schedule that includes:

- Residency orientation lectures – Ground School
- Weekly Academic Half Day
- Weekly Chronic Pain Project Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes (ECHO) rounds
- Selected Addictions lectures
- Selected Psychiatry lectures
- Selected Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation lectures
 - Monthly evening Physical Exam teaching Series
- Pain Medicine Leadership and Administration Day
- Bi-Monthly Department of Anesthesia Chronic Pain Journal Club

2. Pain Medicine Residents must complete the following Online courses during first 3 (three) months of residency:

A. Suboxone Education program (Free registration)

This course prepares physicians, nurses, pharmacists and counsellors/case managers to effectively and safely manage the treatment of clients receiving methadone or buprenorphine opioid dependence. The course is designed to promote interprofessional collaboration among the health care team involved in the delivery of opioid dependence treatment. The core course consists of five online modules and a one-day workshop.

4. Pain Medicine Residents must complete each of the following procedural workshops once during the 2 year residency:

Some Pain Medicine residents plan to become expert in the performance of interventional techniques while others may only wish to become familiar with the indications, contraindications, complications, and outcomes. Regardless, both groups will require adequate exposure to interventional techniques

5. Pain Medicine Residents must join the University of Toronto Centre for the Study of Pain (UTCSP) and sit and participate on one of its sub-committees as an active trainee member; <http://sites.utoronto.ca/pain/>

- The UTCSP is located at the University of Toronto under the collaborative partnership and leadership of the Faculties of Medicine, Nursing, Dentistry, and Pharmacy. The vision of the UTCSP is to be a key academic voice and a leader, both nationally and internationally, in pain research and education. The mission of the UTCSP is to create and disseminate knowledge on pain and inform clinical excellence through interdisciplinary collaboration.
- Residents may choose which sub-committee they join: Knowledge Translation and Networking Subcommittee, Research Subcommittee, Education Subcommittee and the chair of the sub-committee will submit a report to the Pain Medicine Residency Program Director yearly outlining the residents' participation

6. Pain Medicine Residents must maintain a log book

- Maintaining a log of clinical activity helps promote reflective practice. Currently there is no freely available log book that will adequately capture the desired clinical experiences (types of pain, patient encounters, follow-up's and procedures).
- Log books will be discussed at the upcoming Pain Medicine Program Directors Meeting in Ottawa in November 2014. Currently, ACUDA officially owns an Anesthesia Resident Logbook and the Pain Medicine Program Directors hope to modify this to suit the needs of Pain Medicine Residents.
- Until such an electronic specialty-specific log-book exists, residents will be expected to keep a written log (paper or electronic) of their clinical activities and encounters.

7. Pain Medicine Residents must develop a robust portfolio

- Maintenance of a Portfolio also helps promote reflective practice. Residents will be expected to develop a portfolio consisting of the required reflective writing exercises that occur every six months, the five (5) required presentations that they must complete over the residency, their scholarly project proposal and final product, an up-to-date CV and the variety of non-ITER evaluations that they must solicit and collect over the two years.

- The portfolio will be reviewed with the Program Director during the resident-Program Director meeting that occur every six months

FORMAL CURRICULUM OUTLINE

Residency Orientation (Ground School) and Academic Half-Days – Pain Medicine Residency

The academic half-day for the Pain Medicine Residency will be unique in that a small number of residents will be enrolled in the program (2 per year to start). Academic half days will take on a mixed didactic and tutorial format in which discussion between the teacher and students is encouraged and readings are pre-circulated.

Academic half days for Pain Medicine residents will be held every week or every other week over two (2) years, tentatively on Thursday afternoons, and start with their mandatory attendance (online or videoconference) in Project ECHO from 1200-1400. The didactic sessions are a mandatory activity for all residents in the program. Time will be protected for attendance. Attendance results will be reflected on ITER evaluations under the CanMEDS role of "Professionalism." Low overall annual attendance (below 75%) may result in an unsatisfactory rating on resident ITERs or FITERs.

The content will be divided into didactic lectures provided by experts in the field of study, small group sessions, case-based discussions and resident-guided scholarly work, including but not limited to review of pertinent clinical guidelines. Objectives for these sessions are based on the Objectives of Training in the Subspecialty of Pain Medicine outlined by the RCPSC. There is flexibility within the schedule to add lectures that are not included in the current schedule but are identified by the residents to be in line with their personal educational objectives.
