

## **Interprofessional Teaching Award**

This award is given to a Department faculty member who is judged to be an outstanding interprofessional teacher and collaborator both within and outside the anesthesia community. It may be given annually if the selection committee identifies a worthy recipient. An individual may receive this award only once in any ten year period.

## Nomination criteria include an excellent teaching record and demonstrated impact in interprofessional teaching over at least 3 years in any of the following areas:

- a) Excellence in clinical teaching, lectures and seminars
- b) Demonstrated skill in collaboration to contribute to learning in other disciplines
- c) Demonstrated influence that resulted in improved teaching
- d) Development of innovations to improve learning
- e) Active involvement in educational committees and/or administration that has advanced teaching or education

Members of the Department of Anesthesia are invited to nominate candidates.

## Nomination packages must include:

- A nomination letter signed by at least two (2) anesthesia faculty members *and* two (2) persons outside of the department (e.g., Anesthesia Assistants, Respiratory Therapists, RNs, or faculty members from other health care professions
- Up to three (not more) letters of support from other professions (peers, students, or faculty)
- Appropriate teaching evaluation data
- If appropriate, evidence of achievement in educational innovation
- The candidate's Curriculum Vitae

NOTE: The Education Council is the selection panel for awards and members may not contribute to nominations and are not eligible for nomination. They are the Department Chair; the Vice-Chair, Education; Directors of the undergraduate program, fellowships, continuing education, and faculty development; and Directors of the residency programs in anesthesia, family practice anesthesia, and pain medicine.
